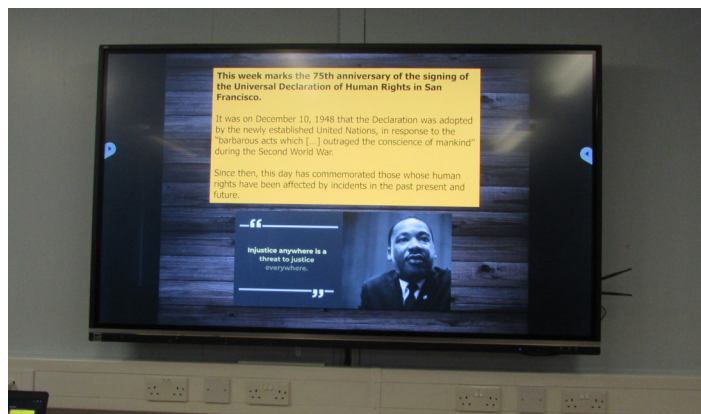
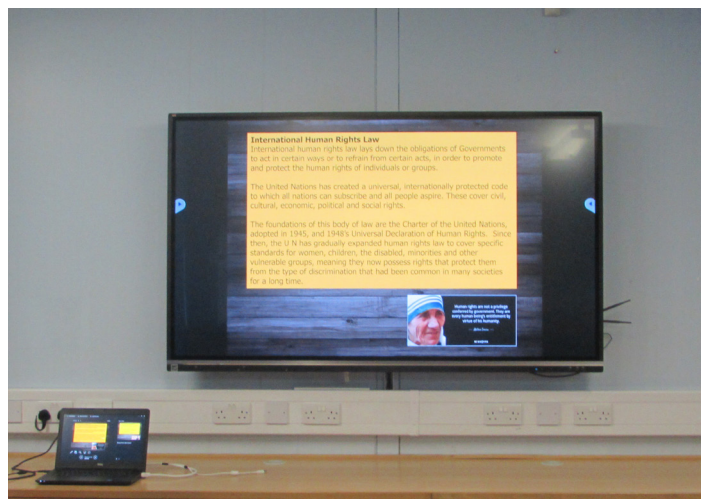


World Human Rights Day Assembly



On Wednesday 5th December, Mr Pyle delivered a whole college assembly to all students on the subject of Human Rights: past, present and future. This was to coincide with International Human Rights Day, which falls on Sunday 10th December. The assembly covered the concept of human rights, including a definition of human rights and a breakdown of the different types of human rights



It also explained the basic history of both the United Nations Human Rights Act and UNICEF, and related it to real life situations around the world today. Finally, students were encouraged to suggest the human rights they perhaps take for granted which others around the world do not benefit from.
