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Sport Science at Parkside

Sport Science students have been working very hard on both practical and theory topics this term. They have been studying physical and skill related components of fitness through performing tests and researching how each component is relevant to different sporting activities. The students have been using their own sporting role models to relate the aspects of their testing.



Year 10 students have begun a new assignment which looks into analysing sports leaders through videos, research and demonstrations. The class are focusing on what makes a successful sports leader and the methods and rules they use to enable them to succeed. The students are using these qualities to help them prepare an evaluation into what makes a successful sporting leader.



The Year 9 students have had a very enjoyable settling in period to their new course. After introductions and expectations, they have been introduced to new sports and participating to create a deeper understanding of multiple sporting backgrounds.

Urgent Mental Health Support - 24/7 Crisis Lines


