Re: Arrangements for the end of term

As we come to the end of what has been a very long and busy term, I am writing to let you know about the arrangements for the end of this term and the start of next term. I am also going to take the opportunity to look back on some of the highlights of the academic year to date.

At Parkside Studio College we have always believed that learning is not just confined to the classroom and our students have had the opportunity to take part in a number of exciting activities this term. These have included Year 10 students taking part in the Jack Petchy Speak Out Challenge. The Brooks Education Group have provided workshops on Self-Esteem and Mental Health to all KS4 students. Year 11 students have taken part in a Careers Advice and Guidance day, which provided them with comprehensive information regarding the next steps in education, employment or training.
